Work Experience

- 30 years of experience (1979-2009) in internal medicine, oncology and haematology, obtained at the Hôpital Universitaire de Genève and abroad. Following seven years of post-graduate training, she was appointed as Chief resident in 1986 and then promoted to Primary consultant in 1993, a role that she worked in until 2009. She is an expert in diagnostic tools and cutting-edge treatment for patients suffering from a range of cancers, such as lymphoma, Hodgkin's lymphoma, myeloma, acute or chronic leukaemia, as well as myeloproliferative and myelodysplastic disorders.
- Consultant in the main French cancer treatment institutes: In 1986 at the Hôpital Saint-Louis de Paris (Prof. E Gluckman) and in 1998 at the Hôpital Henri-Mondor de Paris (Prof. F Reyes).
- From 1984 to 2009, co-director of the allogeneic and autologous bone marrow transplant programme in Geneva, responsible for the external consultation clinic. She played a key role in the creation of the umbilical blood bank in Geneva.
- Responsible for the development of innovative therapy protocols, working with the pharmaceutical industry (including Hoffmann-La Roche and Schering) to design and conduct clinical trials focused primarily on the use of monoclonal antibodies and radio-immunotherapy.
- Regular pre- and post-graduate teaching activities at the Faculty of medicine in the University of Geneva.
