### Competencies

- Acute and chronic pain of the entire spine
- Nerve pain
- Pain after surgeries and injuries
- Various headaches, including migraines

### Treatment Options

- Medication-based pain therapy
- Infusion therapies with ketamine, procaine, and lidocaine
- Myofascial trigger point therapy
- Interventional pain therapy, such as:
  - CT-guided nerve root blockades
  - CT-guided sympathetic nerve blockades
  - CT-guided facet joint blockades (facet joint injections)
  - Image-guided epidural infiltrations
  - Joint infiltrations, muscle infiltrations (e.g., piriformis blockade)
  - Ultrasound-guided interventions (peripheral nerves, joints)
  - Radiofrequency therapy
  - Neurostimulation
- Pain psychotherapy and psychosomatic assessment and therapy
