After moving to the Visceral surgery and transplant department at the Hôpitaux Universitaires de Genève, Dr Vidal Fortuny joined and helped to grow the abdominal wall surgery team, with a focus on minimally invasive techniques.

During his two years within the Thoracic and endocrine surgery department, he trained in surgery of the thyroid and parathyroid, developing new surgical procedures to increase operational safety.

Dr Vidal Fortuny has two specific areas of specialisation:

- **General surgery:** external conditions (surgery of the skin and the subcutaneous layer) and classic conditions, including conditions of the abdominal wall, such as hernias of the digestive tracts: appendicitis, cancer, gastric reflux, diverticulitis, conditions of the anus and gallbladder, and varicose veins.
- **Cervical endocrine surgery:** thyroid and parathyroid conditions, whether benign (which is the majority of cases) or malignant.
